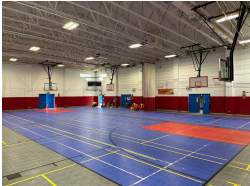

Fitness Center Information

Why go miles out of your way when a premium fitness experience is right in your neighborhood? At the Easton Community Center (ECC) Fitness Center, we have everything you need to achieve your fitness goals.

Location and Convenience: The ECC's Fitness Center provides a close and accessible location for individuals who don't want to drive long distances to exercise.

Variety of Options: The center offers various fitness options, including new aerobic classes and self-guided workouts using state-of-the-art cardio and strength training equipment.

Orientation for Equipment: For new members or those who are unfamiliar with the equipment, orientations are available. These sessions last around 20 minutes and are designed to demonstrate the proper and safe use of the equipment.

Personal Trainers: Personal trainers can be arranged upon request, offering personalized guidance and training. However, this service comes at an additional cost. Please contact us for pricing.

Age Restrictions: The fitness center is available for individuals who are 16 years of age or older. Those who are 14 or 15 years old may be allowed with a doctor's release, indicating that special permission is needed for younger participants.

In cases of medical emergency, a refund will be issued for the remaining balance of class fees when you present a medical certificate or physician's letter to the ECC Program Director. Refunds are not issued for unattended classes.

Class Cancellations

The ECC reserves the right to cancel any class when the minimum enrollment is not met. Earliest possible notification will be given and the participants may choose either a full refund or an ECC credit.

If cancellations are due to inclement weather the ECC does not guarantee make up classes, but will make every effort to schedule a make-up class.

Class Refunds & Credits

If you are unable to attend a registered class session, you must notify the ECC Program Director in writing. A 10% processing fee will be charged per person. Refunds take a minimum of three to four weeks for reimbursement and will be issued by the ECC. An ECC credit, if issued, is valid for one year from the date of issue. Refunds or ECC credits will be issued based on the date of the cancellation as follows:

Cancellation before first class:
90% refund or ECC Credit

Cancellation after first class:
75% ECC credit

Cancellation after second class:
50% ECC credit

Cancellation after the third class:
No ECC credit or refunds

At Playtots, you'll find a friendly, nurturing and safe environment for your young child. Our program is designed to promote the social, emotional, physical and intellectual development of our students. Students also engage in weekly enrichment activities such as Art, Music, Creative Movement, Yoga and Physical Education.

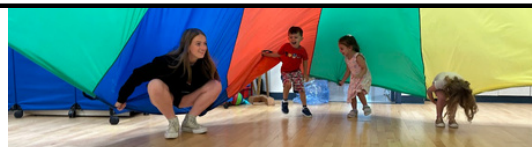

Dog Obedience

Train your dog in real life situations and your dog becomes reliable in real life situations. By the end of the class many dogs have learned basic commands such as sit, down, come, stay, focus, leave it, settle and loose leash walking. This class also addresses common problem areas such as potty training, chewing, biting, digging and barking. Consistent training at home will reinforce the skills they have learned in class.

Puppies generally get a series of distemper vaccinations at 8 weeks, 12 weeks, 16 weeks and sometimes 18 weeks. Puppies should have had at least 2 of the DHL2PP distemper vaccinations before starting class.

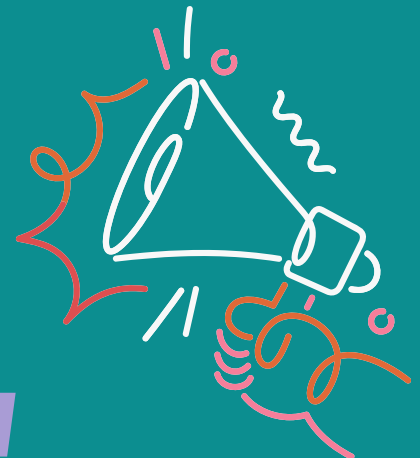
