A Letter From Our Executive Director

Dear neighbors,

This is the first brochure with my name on it, so let me introduce myself the way I'd want to be introduced: I'm the new person at the front desk asking your kids how camp went.

I came to the ECC this July, and here is what struck me first. Easton has more space than almost anywhere in Fairfield County, and the space is the best part of living here. The only trick is finding the people. That is what this building is for. For twenty-three years, this has been where Easton finds each other: at drop-off, on the bench at t-ball, in the camp pickup line, at the finish line of the 5K.

At pickup last week, a dad stopped to tell me his family had just moved to Easton, and that camp had been the thing that made them feel like they belonged here. His kids start Playtots in the fall. Most afternoons now I see him out on the property after pickup, in no rush, just playing with them on the grass.

There is a lot of room to spread out in Easton, and that is the beauty of the place. It also means the moments when we all land in the same spot matter more. That is what one building on Sport Hill Road gets to do. That is my ambition, plainly: I want the ECC to be that place for everyone. Not just the kids. You too!

No one does this alone here, and that is not an accident. It is memberships and program fees, volunteers and coaches who were once campers themselves, and neighbors who decided a town this spread out needed a front porch. If you have been part of that, thank you. It shows in every room of this building.

So consider this your invitation, whatever your age. Pick one thing in these pages and try it. Run the 5K with us on Saturday, October 3rd. Bring your toddler on a Friday morning. Send your teenager on a trip. Come play badminton at nine at night, or just walk in for open gym. Then tell me what's missing, because I'm building next year from what this town actually needs, and I would rather hear it from you than guess. My door is genuinely open.

Beyond Easton: Before and After School in Fairfield

Every school morning, ECC staff are in four Fairfield elementary schools before the first bell and after the last one. North Stratfield, Stratfield, Holland Hill, and Osborn Hill. It looks like homework at a shared table, a science project that got out of hand, a no-bake cooking day, and somewhere to be when the school day ends before the work day does. The same people, every day, who know your kid's name and how the week is going.

Fall is full, but spots do open during the year as families' plans change. Ask to go on the waitlist and we will call you if one comes up. Registration for the next full year opens with the Spring and Summer brochure. Either way, start with George Taxiltaridis at GeorgeT@EastonCC.com or (203) 459-9700. Twenty-three years in, one building on Sport Hill Road, and a good part of what we do happens somewhere else entirely.

Membership

One membership, every generation - available to residents across Fairfield County

A family membership covers everyone living at your address, and it tends to pay for itself by the second program. Here is what comes with it:

- Discounts on programs and camps
- Discounts on children's birthday parties and member-only building rentals
- The supervised after-school program for grades 6–8 (additional fee)
- Free use of the fully equipped fitness center and open gym
- Free member-only events throughout the year

Cost should never be the reason

No one in Easton should miss out on this place because of what it costs. Preschool tuition, camp, after-school care, memberships, sports, and programs for every age can all be reduced on a sliding scale based on household income.

This is for working households whose income does not stretch as far as Fairfield County costs. Anyone can apply: a parent enrolling a child, an adult joining a program, a senior looking for somewhere to belong. If you already receive state or federal assistance, you will not need to submit income documents again.

Every application is confidential. Applying has no effect on your standing here, and no one outside the review sees what you submit.

*Auto-Renewal requires a two-year membership commitment. Membership must be valid through the full duration of a program to receive member rates. Payments by check payable to ECC, or by Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express. Memberships are non-refundable.



Payment, Refunds & Our Facility

Payment Information

Pay online, by phone, or by check payable to ECC (Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express accepted). Mail or hand-deliver completed registration forms with full payment to: ECC Programs, 364 Sport Hill Road, Easton, CT 06612. In a medical emergency, we refund the remaining balance of class fees with a physician's letter to the ECC Program Director. Refunds are not issued for unattended classes.

Class Cancellations

If minimum enrollment isn't met, we may cancel a class with the earliest possible notice, and you choose a full refund or an ECC credit. Weather cancellations: we can't guarantee make-up classes, but we schedule them whenever we can. Closures are posted at CTWeather.com (under Learning Centers), on Channel 12 News, on our social media, or call (203) 459-9700.

Refunds & Credits

- All Deposits are non-refundable
- Cancellations will be charged a \$50 cancellation fee
- Cancellations made more than 30 days prior to the event will receive a full refund, less deposit and cancellation fee
- Cancellations made 15-30 days prior to the event will receive a partial refund based on the program specifications
- Cancellations made less than 15 days prior to the event are not subject to a refund
- Cancellations due to serious illness, injury or death in the family, or unexpected move from the area, affecting the enrollee's ability to attend a program are subject to a pro-rated refund
- Cancellations initiated by ECC will receive a full refund
- Changes or swapping of days within a program will be charged a \$50 change fee

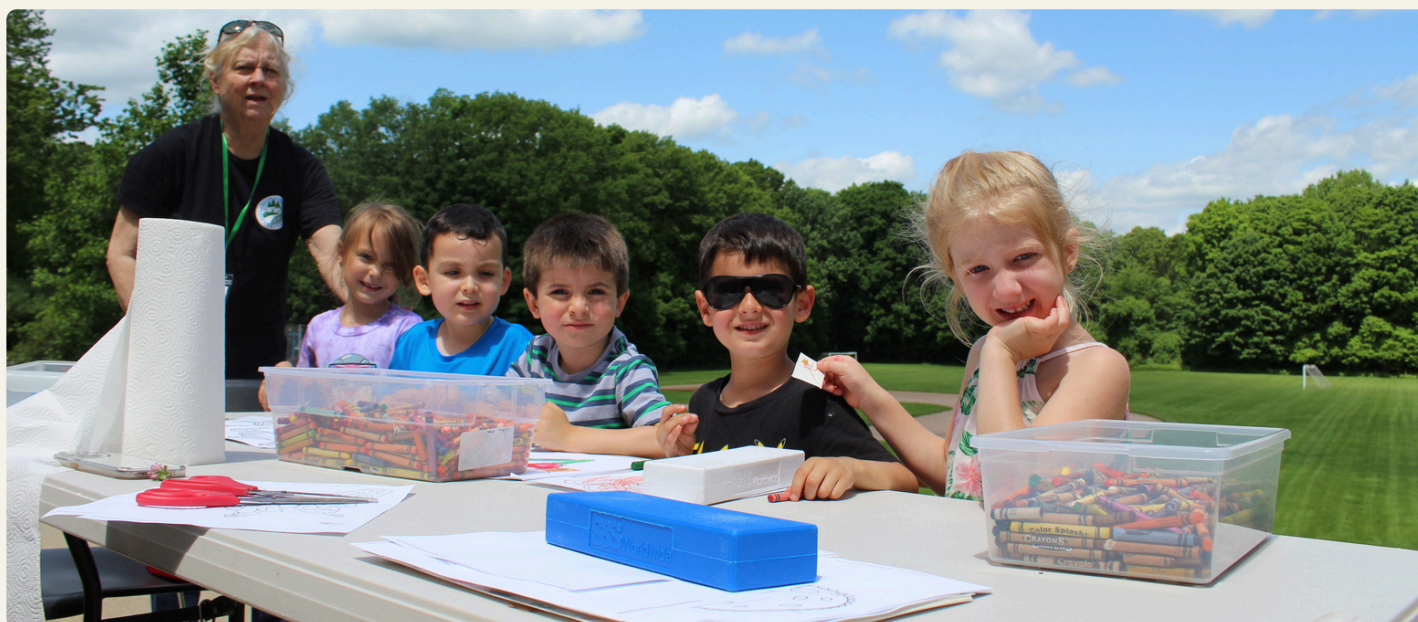

Train your dog in real-life situations and your dog becomes reliable in real life. By the end of class, most dogs know sit, down, come, stay, focus, leave it, settle, and loose-leash walking — and class addresses potty training, chewing, biting, digging, and barking. Consistent practice at home locks it in. Puppies should have at least two DHL2PP distemper vaccinations before starting (typically given at 8, 12, 16, and sometimes 18 weeks).
